1 2 3 4	WHEREAS, the State ofis a sovereign governmental entity and through its elected officials, including the members of the legislature of is the appropriate entity to make law and policy for the people of the State of; and
5 6 7 8 9	WHEREAS, the political subdivisions of the State ofare legally constituted pursuant to the authority of theConstitution and theStatutes and each such entity has a governing board equally capable of making decisions related to the health and welfare of the people of the State of; and
10 11 12 13	WHEREAS, the World Health Organization (WHO), the United Nations (UN) and the World Economic Forum (WEF) are not government entities and do not have any authority to make law or policy that impacts the lives of the people of the State of; and
14 15 16	WHEREAS, the people of the State of have fundamental rights which should not be subject to the influence of non-governmental entities such as the WHO, the UN or the WEF.
17 18 19	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THETHAT the World Health Organization, the United Nations and the World Economic Forum should have no jurisdiction in the State of
20 21 22 23 24 25 26 27 28 29	THAT the state and its political subdivisions, including, but not limited to counties, cities, towns, precincts, water districts, school districts, school administrative units, or quasi-public entities, should not engage in the enforcement of, or any collaboration with the enforcement of, any requirements, instructions, mandates, recommendations, or guidance issued by the World Health Organization, the United Nations or the World Economic Forum, whether directly or indirectly, to also include but not limited to any government, public or private organization acting on behalf of the WHO, UN and WEF, including but not limited to the National Focal Points, the National International Health Regulations (IHR) Authority, the U.S. government's Department of Health and Human Services, Food and Drug

- 2 of Health and the UN/federal/state One Health Agencies.
- 3 THAT any mandates, recommendations, instructions, communications or guidance
- 4 issued by the World Health Organization, the United Nations or the World
- 5 Economic Forum, whether directly or indirectly, to also include but not limited to
- 6 any government, public or private organization acting on behalf of the WHO, UN
- 7 and WEF, including but not limited to the National Focal Points, the National IHR
- 8 Authority, HHS, FDA, CDC, NIH or UN/federal/state One Health agencies should
- 9 not be used in the State of ______ as a basis for action, nor to direct, order or
- 10 otherwise impose, contrary to the constitution and laws of the State of _____
- 11 any requirements whatsoever, including those for masks, vaccines or medical
- 12 testing, or gather any public or private information about the state's citizens or
- 13 residents, and shall have no force or effect in the State of_____.
- 14 THAT the State of ______and all political subdivisions, including, but not
- 15 limited to, counties, cities, towns, precincts, water districts, school districts, school
- 16 administrative units, or quasi-public entities should not accept any funding in
- 17 support for any programs associated with the World Health Organization, United
- 18 Nations, World Economic Forum, whether directly or indirectly, to also include but
- 19 not limited to any government, public or private organization acting on behalf of the
- 20 WHO, UN and WEF, including but not limited to the National Focal Points, the
- 21 National IHR Authority, HHS, FDA, CDC, NIH or UN/federal/state One Health
- 22 agencies.
- 23 THAT no rule, regulation, law, mandate, fee, tax policy, treaty, executive
- 24 agreement, international agreement that violates the legislative powers set forth in
- 25 Article 1 Section 8 of the US Constitution, pertaining to any implementation of
- 26 mandates from the WHO, UN or WEF, should be enforced or implemented by the
- 27 State of ______ or any agency, department, board, commission, political
- 28 subdivision, governmental entity of the state, city, county, municipality, or any
- 29 other political entity.
- 30 THAT fines should be levied for violation of restrictions adopted pursuant to this
- 31 Resolution. And if funding is received in violation of restrictions adopted pursuant
- 32 to this Resolution it should be returned to the funding organization.
