2024-21 Resolution relating to the World Health Organization, the United Nations and the World Economic Forum; expressing intent with regard to policies of state and local government. – _____

1 WHEREAS, the State of _____ is a sovereign governmental entity and through
2 its elected officials, including the members of the legislature of _____ is the
3 appropriate entity to make law and policy for the people of the State of _____;
4 and

5 WHEREAS, the political subdivisions of the State of _____ are legally
6 constituted pursuant to the authority of the _____ Constitution and the
7 _____ Statutes and each such entity has a governing board equally capable of
8 making decisions related to the health and welfare of the people of the State
9 of _____; and

10 WHEREAS, the World Health Organization (WHO), the United Nations (UN) and
11 the World Economic Forum (WEF) are not government entities and do not have any
12 authority to make law or policy that impacts the lives of the people of the State of
13 _____; and

14 WHEREAS, the people of the State of _____ have fundamental rights which
15 should not be subject to the influence of non-governmental entities such as the
16 WHO, the UN or the WEF.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE _____ THAT the World
18 Health Organization, the United Nations and the World Economic Forum should
19 have no jurisdiction in the State of _____.

20 THAT the state and its political subdivisions, including, but not limited to counties,
21 cities, towns, precincts, water districts, school districts, school administrative units,
22 or quasi-public entities, should not engage in the enforcement of, or any
23 collaboration with the enforcement of, any requirements, instructions, mandates,
24 recommendations, or guidance issued by the World Health Organization, the United
25 Nations or the World Economic Forum, whether directly or indirectly, to also
26 include but not limited to any government, public or private organization acting on
27 behalf of the WHO, UN and WEF, including but not limited to the National Focal
28 Points, the National International Health Regulations (IHR) Authority, the U.S.
29 government's Department of Health and Human Services, Food and Drug

1 Administration (FDA),. Centers for Disease Control (CDC) and National Institutes
2 of Health and the UN/federal/state One Health Agencies.

3 THAT any mandates, recommendations, instructions, communications or guidance
4 issued by the World Health Organization, the United Nations or the World
5 Economic Forum, whether directly or indirectly, to also include but not limited to
6 any government, public or private organization acting on behalf of the WHO, UN
7 and WEF, including but not limited to the National Focal Points, the National IHR
8 Authority, HHS, FDA, CDC, NIH or UN/federal/state One Health agencies should
9 not be used in the State of _____ as a basis for action, nor to direct, order or
10 otherwise impose, contrary to the constitution and laws of the State of _____
11 any requirements whatsoever, including those for masks, vaccines or medical
12 testing, or gather any public or private information about the state's citizens or
13 residents, and shall have no force or effect in the State of _____.

14 THAT the State of _____ and all political subdivisions, including, but not
15 limited to, counties, cities, towns, precincts, water districts, school districts, school
16 administrative units, or quasi-public entities should not accept any funding in
17 support for any programs associated with the World Health Organization, United
18 Nations, World Economic Forum, whether directly or indirectly, to also include but
19 not limited to any government, public or private organization acting on behalf of the
20 WHO, UN and WEF, including but not limited to the National Focal Points, the
21 National IHR Authority, HHS, FDA, CDC, NIH or UN/federal/state One Health
22 agencies.

23 THAT no rule, regulation, law, mandate, fee, tax policy, treaty, executive
24 agreement, international agreement that violates the legislative powers set forth in
25 Article 1 Section 8 of the US Constitution, pertaining to any implementation of
26 mandates from the WHO, UN or WEF, should be enforced or implemented by the
27 State of _____ or any agency, department, board, commission, political
28 subdivision, governmental entity of the state, city, county, municipality, or any
29 other political entity.

30 THAT fines should be levied for violation of restrictions adopted pursuant to this
31 Resolution. And if funding is received in violation of restrictions adopted pursuant
32 to this Resolution it should be returned to the funding organization.
